By the end of this year, 2getthere Asia aims to showcase a GRT - an air-conditioned, 24-passenger "pod" - in a live environment in Singapore.

In anticipation of the growing demand in the Asia-Pacific region for automated vehicles, SMRT Services and 2getthere are also working to deepen their strategic relationship to better support 2getthere's development and growth.
