Settlements in brief: Walmart and TechnipFMC

In this article, we highlight settlements with criminal and supervisory authorities around the globe. We discuss the USD 283 million Walmart settlement for allegedly insufficient anti-corruption controls that allowed third-party intermediaries to make improper payments to government officials in China, Mexico, Brazil and India. We also discuss the TechnipFMC settlement, which TechnipFMC claims as the first simultaneous resolution of corruption investigations by US and Brazilian authorities.
